



First Editions of Individual Spellbound Sampler Block Patterns

I have emailed all of you who bought patterns directly from me with updated patterns. If you purchased from the Fat Quarter Shop the following revisions may be relevant:-

Gothic Gatehouse

STEP 7 should read...

...mark a diagonal line on the back of 2 1½" light grey squares (NOT 2½" as stated in the pattern)

STEP 15 should read...

...pressing away from the Gatehouse.

Mervielle du Jour

The diagram for STEP 13 is correct but has been improved.

Moon & Star

STEP 4 should read..

...mark a diagonal line on the back of 2 1½" yellow squares (NOT 2½" as stated in the pattern) and pin, right sides together, to one end of a 1½" x 2½" background piece (NOT 2½" x 4½" as stated in the pattern).

The diagram for STEP 9 should be handed (the written instructions are correct).

You will add borders to EACH side and TOP & BOTTOM in STEP 15.

Moonlit Bat

The diagram for STEP 8 is correct but has been improved.

Pumpkin

STEP 7 should read...

...Repeat on the adjacent corner with the remaining 2½" background square, as shown overleaf. (NOT 1½" as stated in the pattern).

STEP 9 refers to the 2½" x 8½" mid-coral piece.

STEP 10 should read...

...opposite corners of the 2½" x 4½" light grey fabric (1) piece with a 1½" mid-coral square and the remaining 2½" square of light grey (2) fabric...

You will be using 2½" squares of light grey fabric (3) for **STEP 12**.

Raven

There are two 2" x 3" pieces shown on the background Fat Quarter **cutting diagram**: you will only need to cut ONE.
The unlabelled square is 1½".

STEP 3: cut a ½" x 10" piece.

STEP 11 should read...

...First prepare the 2" x 3" background piece...

STEP 14 should refer to Raven's not Owl's legs...

STEP 18 has been omitted and should read...

Using the cover photo as your guide, backstitch the Raven's eyelid using cream embroidery floss.

Toadstools

STEP 4 should read...

...to the corner of the 2½" x 6½" coral piece...

The diagrams for **STEPS 6, 7 & 9** have been labelled to match the text.

STEP 11 should read...

...a 2½" x 14½" background piece to top and bottom...

Wise Owl

STEP 2: cut a ½" x 10" piece.

STEP 9 should read...

...mark a diagonal line on the back of a 3½" light grey square...

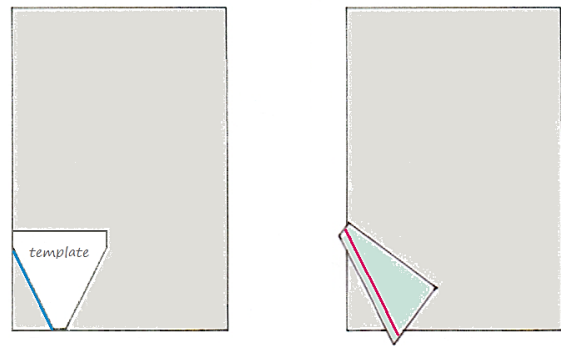
STEP 13 should read...

...First prepare the 2" x 3" background piece...

STEP 14

Some of the words in the instructions were incorrectly highlighted. These have been amended and the accompanying diagram improved, as follows: -

Using the **Triangle-in-a-Square (TS) template**, **mark** a placement line on the lower left-hand corner of the 4½" x 6½" light grey (1) piece. Position the trimmed background piece - right side together – on the placement line and **stitch ¼" away** before flipping 'open' and pressing. Turn your unit to the wrong side and trim, using the background piece as a guide.



The notes at the bottom of the pattern should refer to the Owl block NOT the Mervielle du Jour block.
